


Can You See the Truth?

<sup>31</sup> To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. <sup>32</sup> Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." 33 They answered him, "We are Abraham's descendants and have never been slaves of anyone. How can you say that we shall be set free?"

<sup>34</sup> Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. <sup>35</sup> Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever. <sup>36</sup> So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. <sup>37</sup> I know that you are Abraham's descendants. Yet you are looking for a way to kill me, because you have no room for my word.

"hold to" = "stay... remain... tarry... dwell... endure... and abide"

When we "abide" in the knowledge of the teaching of Jesus... remain in it, dwell in it... then we will "know" the truth, and the truth enables a life of freedom!

Ask God to help you <u>live in</u> the truth by "holding" to the teaching of Jesus.
